MEETING MINUTES

The Board having reviewed the May 25, 2022 meeting minutes, said minutes were approved as submitted.

TREASURER'S REPORT

The May 31, 2022 and April 30, 2022 Treasurer's reports were presented by Art Heitlauf. Art described the movements in each of the accounts and reviewed the expenses in May for plumbing and electrical work. There were no expenses in June.

MOTION: A motion was made to approve the Northside Electrical invoice. It was seconded and passed unanimously.

MOTION: A motion was made to accept the Treasurer's Reports dated May 31, 2022 and April 30 2022. It was seconded and passed unanimously.

OLD BUSINESS

1. Lead Mining Update

Doug Daugherty Provided an update to the Board. The projected start date is August 20/21. Some areas of the shot-fall zone are not suitable for the rotary mower (swales and slopes). Some type of articulating flail cutter on an excavator (or equivalent machine) is required. Craig Rhea will send Doug information on prior quotes to do this work. We will use the rotary mower on most areas and acquire bids for the swales and slopes. Brad Carbaugh will drop any trees that require removal. 4B Farms has provided access to the well on the north side of the property.

2. Board Action for Gravel Approval

Craig Rhea e-mailed the Board on June 13. Due to the rain and resulting pothole mess he recommended that the Board authorize the Operator to purchase up to \$5000 worth of gravel to make repairs in advance of the OR State NSCA Championship. The Board responded electronically to approve this expense.

MOTION: A motion was made to ratify and document in the Minutes the Boards authorization on June 13/14 of the purchase by the Operator of up to \$5000 of gravel for necessary road repair. The motion was seconded and passed unanimously.

OPERATOR'S REPORT

Dave Fiedler presented the Operator's Report. The following items were discussed:

- 1. The NSCA State Championship last month went smoothly. 148 shooters in the main event.
- 2. The new RV electrical system, a project completed last year, is performing perfectly.
- 3. The SuperSport Showdown was held last weekend and attracted 73 shooters in the main event.
- 4. New staff, Geo, Eric, and Phil are working well.
- 5. As soon as there is a bit more moisture, will be doing road grading around the course.
- 6. Number 7 Skeet High House needs a new door. Michael Sullivan to handle.
- 7. Skeet Houses have been pressure washed and are awaiting paint.

NEW BUSINESS

1. Oregon State Business Registry Renewal

Michael Sullivan reported that the registry renewal was processed and contact information updated.

2. 2022 Capital Improvement Plan

After a short discussion it was agreed that the Board will wait to see the outcome of the mining initiative before prioritizing any additional capital improvements.
